**MEETING CALLED TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order at 12:00 p.m. with Acting Chairperson Richard Cherry presiding.

**I. PUBLIC HEARING**

**A. Certificate of Appropriateness: HPC 014-2013. Mineral Palace Park, 1500 N. Santa Fe, Mineral Palace Park Band Shell.** Application to paint a decorative element on the band shell.

The Honorable Judge William Martinez appeared and testified before the board in support of the application.

No one spoke in opposition.

Motion to approve by Webb, second by Tucker with staff conditions:

1. Approve the proposed motif/design in black and white to only be painted on the front and rear arch edge as clarified by the applicant.

**Motion Approved, 4-0.**

**II. OLD / NEW BUSINESS**

1. **Youth Summit Update.** Broadhead informed the commissioners the Youth Summit would be held June 20, 2013 and they would be needed for a Mock Preservation Commission hearing.
2. **Updates on city Grants.** Broadhead briefed the HPC on the Goodnight, Memorial Hall, and Eiler's Grants.

3. **Curb Stamp Discussions.** Campbell discussed a recent article in the Chieftain she had written and discussed the City's policy regarding historic infrastructure and curb stamps representing names of streets and mentioned that the ones signifying street names that have changed are especially important. Campbell discussed the possibility of landmarking the stamps. Webb suggested it would not be difficult to landmark most stamps since they are on City property.
