7 SPECIAL EVENTS PERMIT APPLICATION-BEER, WINE & SPIRITUOUS LIQUOR-HARP FOUNDATION, NEW EVENT MANAGER: CHRISTINE PITTMAN, (EVENTS TO BE HELD SEPTEMBER 20TH & 21ST, 2013. ADDRESS OF EVENTS: LOCATED ON THE RIVERWALK CHANNEL LEVEL – NEAR PBR NEXT TO THE FIRE PIT, 101 S. UNION AVENUE)

New event manager, Christine Pittman, 406 E. Gentry Drive, Pueblo West, CO was sworn in and answered questions from the Board. Ms. Pittman explained this Special Event application is for the Chili and Frijoles Festival. All proceeds raised will go to HARP. Ms. Pittman will be responsible for supervising the event. There is one liquor distribution point. Four individuals will be selling/serving liquor at the event and they have previous experience in liquor awareness training. Ms. Pittman stated she was a certified TIPS trainer; however her certification expired in November. She explained snacks and food from other vendors will be available throughout the event. Ms. Pittman described approved forms of identification and stated their policy for checking the age of their patrons will be to check anyone who looks under the age of 40. Once the proper age is verified, they will be given a wrist band. TNT will be assigned to maintain order on the licensed premises and alcohol will not be allowed off the licensed premises. The premises will be secured with the use of barricades as well as with TNT Security.

Mr. Ferris, seconded by Mr. Rose, moved to approve this Special Events permit. Roll Call: Ayes—Ferris, Harrison, Pullaro and Rose. Motion carried unanimously.

8 RETAIL WAREHOUSE STORAGE PERMIT: RETAIL LIQUOR STORE LIQUOR LICENSE—IN FAMILY ENTERPRISE, LLC D/B/A PUEBLO BLVD. DISCOUNT LIQUOR, 1616 W. PUEBLO BLVD. (Warehouse location: 1616 W. Pueblo Blvd.)

Owners Evette and James In, 5427 Costa Mesa Drive were sworn in and answered questions from the Board. Mrs. In explained they have purchased a 40' container as an additional storage area for their alcohol. It will be more convenient for them as the container is on their property next to the liquor store. It is not a permanent structure. The container will be locked and is fenced in. Mr. In also explained they have a surveillance camera so they will not have any problem keeping an eye on it.

Mr. Rose, seconded by Mr. Ferris, moved to approve the Retail Warehouse Storage permit. Roll Call: Ayes—Ferris, Harrison, Pullaro and Rose. Motion carried unanimously.
