New manager Todd A. Unwin, 218 E. Routt was sworn in and answered questions from the Board. The moral character of Mr. Unwin was satisfactory to the Board. He has worked at another Applebee's location and this establishment has never had a violation. Mr. Unwin stated they employ 60-70 employees and some of their cooks have a criminal history but are not on probation. They check references on potential employees. Mr. Unwin described approved forms of identification and stated their policy for checking the age of their patrons is to ask for identification if the customer appears under the age of 30 or if there is any doubt that the customer is of age. Mr. Unwin explained he is certified in Serve-Safe Alcohol. He further explained their company has an in-house program and the employees are required to take and pass a class 1-2 times per year. He stated the employee must score 100% on the test or they fail.

Mr. DiFatta, seconded by Mr. Rose, moved to approve this Manager Registration. Roll Call: Ayes—DiFatta, Ferris, Harrison, Pullaro and Rose. Motion carried unanimously.


**9 PERMIT APPLICATION AND REPORT OF CHANGES- MANAGER REGISTRATION –  
TAVERN LIQUOR LICENSE: BROKEN DOLLAR, INC. D/B/A BROKEN DOLLAR SALOON,  
2301 LAKE AVENUE (PAMELA GALLEGOS REPLACES MERCY GALLEGOS)**

New manager Pamela Ann Gallegos, 2621 Cheyenne Avenue was sworn in and answered questions from the Board. Ms. Gallegos explained she received a deferred sentence for a drug charge in 2006. In further questioning from the Board regarding this charge, it was determined that she pled guilty and received a 2-year deferred sentence for felony possession of a controlled substance (methamphetamine). Ms. Gallegos stated she has only worked at this establishment. They currently employ 2 employees, including her. Ms. Gallegos explained since her mother's passing, she and another family member are working to keep the bar open. Ms. Gallegos described approved forms of identification and explained her experience as a bar owner has taught her what to watch for in checking the age of their patrons and she does ask for I.D. if there is any doubt. Ms. Gallegos was given a copy of the State's certified vendors list of Seller & Server Trainers. The Board explained how beneficial it would be for her and her employees to attend a liquor awareness class and she stated she would like to attend a class of this nature.

Mr. Pullaro, seconded by Mr. DiFatta, moved to approve this Manager Registration. Roll Call: Ayes—DiFatta, Ferris, Harrison, Pullaro and Rose. Motion carried unanimously.
