## **Residential Handicap Parking Sign Request**

The City of Pueblo's Public Works Transportation Division addresses the issue of designating **residential on-street** handicap parking spaces for eligible citizens. An eligible citizen must possess a **valid driver's license, current handicap parking permit or license plate** (available from the County Clerk's office <https://county.pueblo.org/clerk-and-recorder-department/persons-disabilities-placards>) and **is one of the drivers of the vehicle**. The property for which the request is being made **cannot have a driveway or off-street parking access from an alley**. Any exceptions will be made at the discretion of the Public Works Director. If both criteria are met the citizen may request a designated handicap on-street parking space. Once completed, the application will be reviewed by the Public Works Transportation Division. Citizens will be notified about the request once eligibility has been determined, typically 5 to 7 business days. It is important to note that although the handicap accessible parking is installed specifically for the requesting party, the space is available to anyone displaying a valid handicap parking permit or license plate. Permits are renewable after three years. For more information contact the Transportation Division at 719-553-2722.
