The Courts have nothing to do with a driver's license being suspended, revoked, or denied, other than mandatory reporting of convictions to the Department of Motor Vehicles (D.M.V.). In addition to suspensions based upon accumulation of points, there are fifty or more other provisions in the Colorado Revised Statutes upon which the D.M.V. may rely to suspend, revoke, or deny a driver's license. The more common reasons encountered by the City of Pueblo Municipal Court are as follows:

- **A second or subsequent conviction of Possession or Consumption of Alcohol by Minor (under 21 YOA) or a first conviction of Possession or Consumption of Alcohol by Minor (under 21 YOA) in which the minor fails to complete court ordered classes or treatment.**
- **Any traffic or juvenile violation in which a**

warrant is issued for the defendant's arrest.

Generally speaking, from a "points" accumulation standpoint, the D.M.V. will suspend someone's driving privileges if points are accumulated as follows:

ADULT (21 YOA OR OLDER):

Accumulation of twelve (12) points or more within any twelve (12) consecutive months or eighteen (18) points or more within any twenty-four (24) consecutive months.

MINOR (18 YOA – 20 YOA):

Accumulation of nine (9) points or more within any twelve (12) consecutive months, or twelve (12) points or more within any twenty-four (24) consecutive months, or fourteen (14) points or more for violations occurring after reaching the age of eighteen (18) years.

MINOR (16 YOA – 17 YOA):

Accumulation of more than five (5) points within any twelve (12) consecutive months, or more than six (6) points for violations occurring prior to reaching the age of eighteen (18) years.

Whenever an arrest warrant is issued in a traffic related case, the Colorado Department of Motor Vehicles requires the Court to order the imposition of a Colorado Department of Motor Vehicles Administrative Processing Fee in the amount of \$30.00 and a hold will be placed on the drivers license of the person named. This hold will be applied to out of state driver licenses also.

MUST BE PAID AT THE MUNICIPAL COURT ONLY.
