

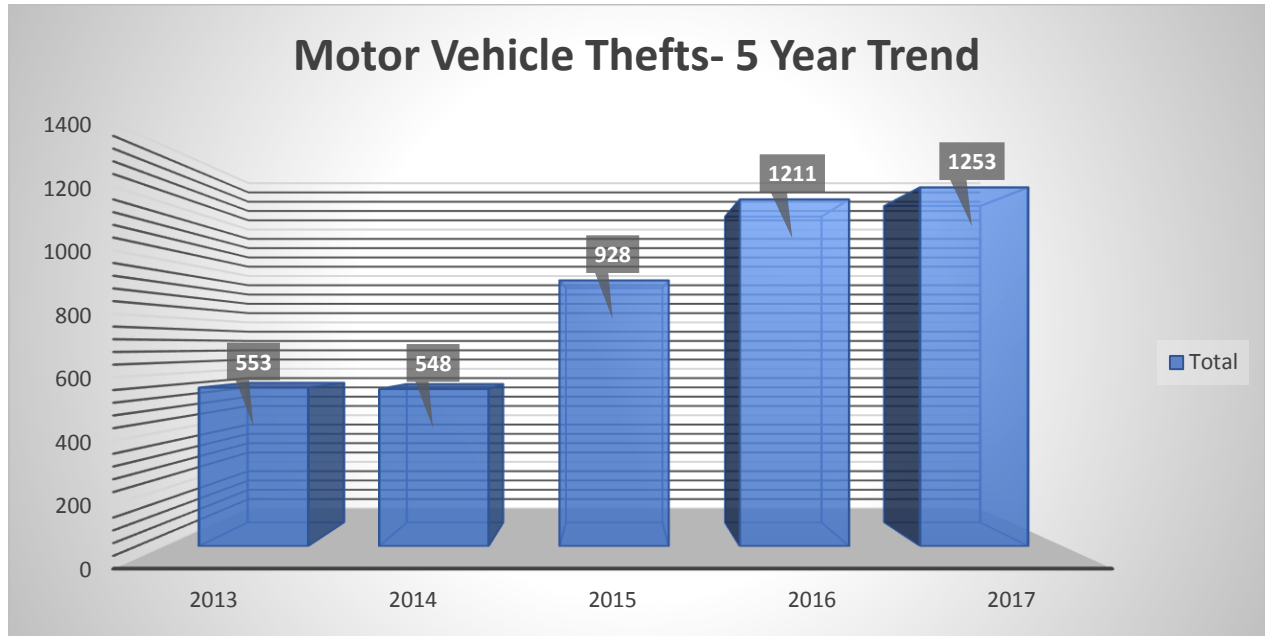


Pueblo Police Department



2017 Motor Vehicle Theft Report

In 2017 there were 1,253 stolen vehicles. 819 were recovered in Pueblo Police Department's jurisdiction. That is a 65% recovery rate.



*Honda is the top reported stolen vehicle, followed by Ford, Chevy, Toyota, and Dodge.

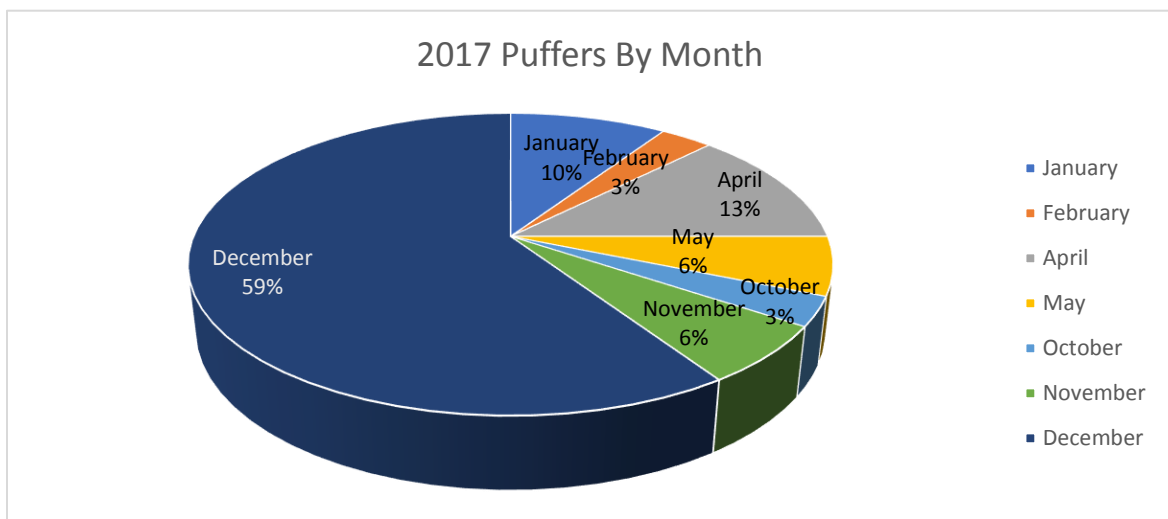

In 2017, there were 32 motor vehicle thefts in direct correlation to puffing. In the month of December there were 19 reported which composed of 59% of puffing casings.



CRIME PREVENTION TIPS:

- ✓ Be cognizant of where you park and the opportunity it may provide to criminals.
- ✓ Do not leave your car running unattended (without an automatic starting system).
- ✓ Don't leave spare keys or try to hide keys in your vehicle, the criminals know where to look.
- ✓ Do not leave items of value or perceived items of value in your car to attract criminals.
- ✓ Report suspicious activity to police, such as suspicious vehicles and people.
- ✓ Purchase an anti-theft steering wheel lock and/or pedal lock device and use it.
- ✓ Consult with a mechanic on installing a detachable steering wheel.
- ✓ Consult with a mechanic on installing a hidden kill switch.
- ✓ Purchase a GPS tracking device to assist with recovery.
- ✓ Don't leave garage door openers in your car.
- ✓ Purchase alarm stickers for your windows.
- ✓ Lock your doors and roll up your windows.
- ✓ Use an alarm if you have one.
