DA Alcohol/Drug (1 Day) \$75

(Juvenile, Adult, Spanish Formats)

Design is based on a "Harm Reduction model, which inspires clients to go from pre-contemplation to contemplation. Topics: Attitudes & Beliefs: Consequences & Dangers: Bio-chemistry & Pharmacology: Impaired Driving .

DA Intensive Alcohol/Drug (2 days) \$145 per client

***Parent must attend with juvenile client**

(Juvenile, Adult, Spanish Formats)

Course is designed for clients who have ongoing difficulties with drugs or alcohol. The group process is the key component to the success of this program. Clients will be given the tools necessary to make positive changes and eliminate self-destructive behaviors.

DUI Level 1 DUI/DWAI (3 Days) \$225 Alcohol Education

Utilizing the "Impaired Driver Education Program", this 12 hour, Level 1 DUI/DWAI Alcohol Education model is for first-time offenders. This program reduces recidivism by teaching driving safety education related to alcohol and other drugs whereby changing clients attitudes and behaviors.

THC THC-Marijuana \$70

This Program is designed to educate THC users about the impact of THC on the brain, marijuana laws, the possible hazards edibles present and driving dirty. This workshop takes a harm reduction approach and affords clients an opportunity to consider their influences, personal situation, goals and consequences of their choices.

TNT Teens and Tobacco™ (1/2 Day) \$50

Educating teens on the harmful effects of tobacco products and offering them realistic strategies for quitting.

PT Petty Theft (1 Day) \$75

(Juvenile, Adult, Spanish Formats)

A proactive seminar designed to help individuals internalize the concept of self-responsibility and respect for others property. This interactive workshop examines values, influences and goals in a positive learning environment. Clients are given the tools necessary to make positive changes, getting more of what they want.

PT Repeat Offender Petty Theft™ (2 Days) \$145

(Juvenile, Adult Formats)

Designed for individuals who have ongoing difficulties with theft. This program will assist clients in understanding where negative behavior may be originating from, and what paths can be taken to make positive changes

VIP Violence is Preventable™ (1 Day) \$75

(Juvenile, Adult, Spanish Formats)

Designed to teach clients that violence is preventable, when responsible choices are made. This class offers the skills necessary to manage anger in appropriate ways and assist in understand how to effectively resolve conflicts. Topics: effective communication skills: Stress Management Techniques.

CIP Conflict Intervention Program (2 days) \$145 per client

(Juvenile, Adult Formats)

Designed for clients who have ongoing difficulties with aggressive behaviors. Offering the skills and resources necessary to mitigate behavior before violence occurs.

DISC Discovering Better Choices™ (1Day) \$75

(Juvenile, Adult, Spanish Formats)

Offers new perspectives and provides the necessary tools to make better choices in life. The interactive style of the class keeps clients interested and active throughout the day. Personal values, the impact of influences and the consequences of choices help clients to better evaluate decision making and improve impulse control.

EDUCATION PROGRAMS

DD 1st Response Defensive Driving™ \$60

(English, Spanish Formats)

(Taught by first responders)

Provides awareness about driving and attitudes, avoiding collisions, driving conditions, impulse control, the importance of eliminating distractions and substance use while driving.

DD Level 2 Defensive Driving (1 Day - 7 hrs) \$110

Focuses the client's attention on changing aggressive, distracted and impulsive driving habits to embrace coping mechanisms that enhance driving awareness. Additionally, the level of empathy clients have for other drivers is raised in this one day extended format.

PAR Responsible Parenting For All Ages™ \$150 couple \$225

Designed to improve existing parenting skills, offer new ideas for dealing effectively with everyday situations and promote healthy, stable relationships in the home. This program is designed to assist parents in examining their current attitudes and how their behaviors impact their children.

FO Female Offenders \$75

This powerful and engaging seminar utilizes a Cognitive Behavioral approach coupled with Social Learning Theory. The Female Offender program is highly interactive and offers women the opportunity to address issues unique to their population in a safe and controlled environment.

YO Young Offenders \$50 age (10-12)

Young Offenders is a progressive program for students between the ages of 9-12 years. This program utilizes hands on, experimental exercises and activities to teach youth how to make healthy choices and positive decision making.
