Resources to take advantage of!

- Register your cell phone with the Emergency Telephone Notification System Opt-In
 - Neighborhood Emergency Incidents
 - Missing Person Alerts
 - Special Community Notifications
 - Wanted Persons Alerts
 - Evacuation Strategies
- Special Needs Registry
 - For households who have members who may be immobile or having medical issues which may hinder their abilities to help them selves in an emergency situation
 - Use it to provide key locations or lock box codes for your house or apartment




Passenger in Vehicle

Passenger is Autistic

- *Loud noises, smells, textures, objects, police lights, sirens or people may elicit negative behavior(s)
- *if possible; it is best to hold out your hand and allow him/her to take your hand or direct them to follow you
- *Explain what is happening before doing it. Many non-verbal autistics understand & respond to language. Be sensitive!

GET DESCRIPTION SAAVY!




"The guy has a gun!"
What's it look like?

"The guy is in a blue shirt/jersey!"
What kind?

"They're in a silver car!"
What kind?

If you dont know directions, use a point of reference. For example, he is on Abriendo headed towards Dutch Clark. NOTE: UP is not a direction! UP means you are hovering. HOVERING is out of our jurisdiction!



Need to Call 911?
Here's What You Should Expect!

Top 8 Questions

- Location—WHERE ARE YOU?
- What happened?
- When did it happen?
- Is there a suspect on scene? GIVE DESCRIPTIONS!
- Are there weapons involved?
- Are there vehicles involved? GIVE DESCRIPTION/PLATE!
- Directions of Travel?
- Make sure YOU are calling from a safe location!

DID YOU KNOW?

- Thefts under \$1,000 with no suspect information can be reported online?
 P2C reporting gives you options that could save you a lengthy response time or a trip to the station! Check out what other crimes can be reported and what other resources are available with this link!

- If you need to report a hit and run with no suspect information or are involved in an accident and both parties agree on what occurred you can come down to the station and file a counter report together for insurance purposes OR use the Crash site through CSP to make a report online.

NOTE: If there are injuries in the crash or a vehicle needs to be towed, an officer WILL need to respond!

TIPS AND TRICKS!

PREVENT YOURSELF AND OTHERS FROM BECOMING VICTIMS!

- **BREAK UP YOUR ROUTINE!**
 Vary your times and routes to work and school making your daily patterns harder to memorize
- **BE AWARE OF YOUR SURROUNDINGS!**
 If something looks out of place it probably is! Call the police and have it checked out!
- **KEEP YOUR PORCH AND SURROUNDING AREA WELL LIT AND CLEAR OF CLUTTER!**
- **DON'T APPEAR DISTRACTED WHEN YOUR OUT IN PUBLIC!**
 Don't text and walk
 Don't take shortcuts through alley's or past abandon or condemned buildings
- **DON'T LEAVE VALUABLES IN YOUR CAR!**
- **IF YOU THINK YOU'RE BEING FOLLOWED GO INTO THE NEAREST PUBLIC PLACE AND CALL 911!**
- **FORM A NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH IN YOUR AREA TO LOOK OUT FOR EACH OTHER!**
