One Male Deceased in Early Morning Shooting

June 25, 2019 [FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE]



On June 25, 2019 at approximately 4:00 a.m., Pueblo police officers responded to the 1000 block of E. 11th Street regarding a male laying in the street. Upon arrival, officers determined that the male was deceased.

The initial investigation revealed that a disturbance took place in the same location sometime around 2:00 a.m. Parties were heard yelling in an apparent altercation, and one or more gunshots may have been heard. A white pick-up truck and a black car were seen leaving in different directions after the disturbance.

At this point in the investigation no suspects have been identified or taken into custody. The victim's identity will be released by the Pueblo County Coroner's Office upon notification of next-of-kin.

This incident marks Pueblo's eighth homicide of 2019, and the second in three days.
