### About the Project

Part 1, completed in 2017, includes an 84-page historic narrative of Downtown Pueblo, and surveys of buildings (26 intensive, 125 reconnaissance). Part 2 will intensively survey 15 more places, and update the historic narrative. The narrative will add histories for influential persons, events, and changes to buildings that were significant to the historic commercial development of downtown. We will cultivate an understanding of Historic Downtown Pueblo in ways important to property and business owners. We invite them to get involved by promoting ways historic preservation can be a tool for economic development.
