

PUEBLO PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT'S **"SAFE RECOVERY" PLAN TO REOPEN FACILITIES**

Stay at Home Phase – Parks and Recreation facilities have been closed since Governor Jared Polis' "Stay at Home Order" was implemented March 25 and expired April 26, 2020. Maintaining "social distancing" of 6-feet or more was determined as a critical first step in preventing the spread of COVID-19.

Safer at Home Phase – On April 27, 2020, Governor Polis issued a "Safer at Home Executive Order" which began the next phase to fight the COVID-19 pandemic.

New Safer at Home Phase – On June 2, 2020, Governor Polis extended the "Safer at Home Executive Order" while lifting specific restrictions that would encourage more Coloradans to get outdoors. This phase will extend through July 1, 2020.

On June 11, 2020, the City and County of Pueblo received approval of a variance request from portions of Public Health Order 20-18 from the Colorado Department of Public Health & Environment that increases, in permitted sizes of indoor and outdoor gatherings and activities while continuing to follow "social distancing" requirements of 6-feet.

Protect Our Neighbors Phase – On July 7, 2020, Governor Polis announced his "Protect Our Neighbors" Phase for communities that meet certain criteria due to low disease prevalence, manageable outbreaks, and hospitals that can serve all who need care without being overwhelmed by COVID-19 surges. Capacity guidelines will be evaluated and approved by our local public health agency.

The following timeline and guidelines are recommended as the next phase for safe reopening of Pueblo Park and Recreation facilities.

PUEBLO ICE ARENA PHASE I REOPENING BY RESERVATION ONLY

YOUTH (8 YRS & OLDER) HOCKEY AND FREESTYLE FIGURE SKATING PRACTICE ONLY
ADULT HOCKEY AND FREESTYLE FIGURE SKATING PRACTICE ONLY

On Ice Capacity: 10 skaters maximum plus 2 coaches

Four Sessions Per Day, Monday-Tuesday-Wednesday

Daily Session 1: 11:00am skaters enter, 11:15am-12:15pm session, 12:30pm skaters exit building
12:30pm-1:00pm Staff Cleaning/Disinfecting in preparation for start of next session

Daily Session 2: 1:00pm skaters enter, 1:15pm-2:15pm session, 2:30pm skaters exit building
2:30pm-3:00pm Staff Cleaning/Disinfecting in preparation for start of next session

Daily Session 3: 3:00pm skaters enter, 3:15pm-4:15pm session, 4:30pm skaters exit building
4:30pm-5:00pm Staff Cleaning/Disinfecting in preparation for start of next session

Daily Session 4: 5:00pm skaters enter, 5:15pm-6:15pm session, 6:30pm skaters exit building
6:30pm-7:00pm Staff Cleaning/Disinfecting in preparation for start of next day

1. Avoid recreating in public spaces if anyone in your household is experiencing COVID-19 like symptoms.
2. All staff and coaches will be required to wear masks. Skaters will not be required wear masks while on ice only entering and exiting building.
3. All registration and payments will be done online (CIVICREC), financial transactions will take place at the arena.
4. Ice Arena staff will monitor entrance and exit into the building to only allow registered skaters during their scheduled sessions.
5. The Ice Arena's center double doors leading into grandstand area and locker room access will be closed.

6. No spectators allowed.
7. No skate rental. Skaters must arrive with their own skates. No sharing skates.
8. All locker rooms will be closed.
9. Player bench areas will be closed.
10. Drinking fountains will not be available. It is suggested for players to bring their own prefilled water bottles.
11. Concession area will be closed.
12. Ice Arena grandstands will be closed.
13. No jump harnesses will be allowed for figure skaters.
14. At no time will skaters be removed and/or shared with other skaters.
15. No spitting allowed anywhere.
16. No hockey games allowed. Skills practice only.
17. All skaters will be required to come to their session fully prepared for their session except for skates.
18. All skaters and coaches shall practice "self-sanitizing" of their equipment to assist in maintaining the sanitization of the facility.
19. Recommended that all staff, skaters, and coaches please use sanitizer before and after using any equipment.
20. All skaters are required to maintain the "social distancing" requirement of 6-feet the entire time while on the ice.
21. Skaters must arrive no earlier than 15 minutes prior to their scheduled session and will be required to exit the building within 15 mins following their scheduled session to allow for proper cleaning and sanitizing for next scheduled session.

PARK SHELTER RESERVATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED BEGINNING MONDAY, JULY 13, 2020

OUTDOOR PARK SHELTERS/GAZEBOS

1. Avoid recreating in public spaces if anyone in your household is experiencing COVID-19 like symptoms.
2. In order to achieve 6-ft "social distancing", the limit of occupancy for each outdoor park picnic shelter will be 50% of designated capacity and will not exceed more than 100 people at any given time. Reservation will highlight capacity of reserved shelter or gazebo.
3. Parties of 10 users or less are still on a "first-come", "first-serve" basis with no permit required.
4. City Park's Centennial Rotary 43 Pavilion has reduced capacity of 50.
 - a. Fee of \$100 is due at time of reservation along with a \$100 refundable damage/COVID-19 Contact Tracing deposit.
5. A COVID-19 Contact Tracing deposit of \$100 will be required for ALL reservations/permits and is due at the time of reservation. The COVID-19 Contact Tracing deposit will be refunded once the required Contact Tracing list of event attendees is returned to the Parks and Recreation Administrative Office, 800 Goodnight Avenue, Pueblo, CO 81005.
6. All patrons will be required to maintain the "social distancing" requirement of 6-feet at all times.
7. It is recommended that all patrons utilizing the outdoor park shelter/gazebo shall wear masks.
8. NO BOUNCE HOUSES.
9. It is recommended that patrons bring their own sanitizing wipes and disinfect prior to utilizing tables and benches located within the park shelter.

OUTDOOR PARK PICNIC AREAS

1. Avoid recreating in public spaces if anyone in your household is experiencing COVID-19 like symptoms.
2. In order to achieve 6-ft "social distancing", the limit of occupancy for each designated outdoor park picnic area will not exceed more than 100 people at any given time. Reservations will highlight capacity of reserved park area.
3. Parties of 10 users or less are still on a "first-come", "first-serve" basis with no permit required.

4. A COVID-19 Contact Tracing deposit of \$100 will be required for ALL reservations/permits and is due at the time of reservation. The Damage/COVID-19 Contact Tracing deposit will be refunded once the required Contact Tracing list of event attendees is returned to the Parks and Recreation Administrative Office, 800 Goodnight Avenue, Pueblo, CO 81005.
5. It is recommended that all patrons shall wear masks.
6. All patrons will be required to maintain the “social distancing” requirement of 6-feet at all times.
7. It is recommended that patrons bring their own sanitizing wipes and disinfect prior to utilizing tables that are located within the park picnic areas.

INDOOR GEORGE L. WILLIAMS PAVILION

1. Avoid recreating in public spaces if anyone in your household is experiencing COVID-19 like symptoms.
2. In order to achieve 6-ft “social distancing”, the limit of occupancy for the George Williams Indoor Pavilion will not exceed more than 100 people at any given time.
3. George L. Williams Indoor Pavilion fees:
 - a. Refundable damage/COVID-19 Contact Tracing deposit of \$175 required at time of reservation
 - b. The Damage/COVID-19 Contact Tracing deposit will be refunded once the required Contact Tracing list of event attendees is returned to the Parks and Recreation Administrative Office, 800 Goodnight Avenue, Pueblo, CO 81005.
 - c. Four hours minimum @ \$130. Each additional hour, \$35 per hour due at time of reservation
 - d. All day reservation (6am to 10pm), \$175
4. NO ALCOHOL. Deposit will be forfeited immediately.
5. It is recommended that all patrons utilizing the George Williams Indoor Pavilion shall wear masks.
6. All patrons will be required to maintain the “social distancing” requirement of 6-feet at all times.
7. No tables or chairs will be available. Patron utilizing the George Williams Indoor Pavilion must provide their own tables and chairs.

CITY PARK CABOOSE AND PATIO PICNIC AREA

1. Avoid recreating in public spaces if anyone in your household is experiencing COVID-19 like symptoms.
2. In order to achieve 6-ft “social distancing”, the limit of occupancy for each outdoor park picnic shelter will be 50% of designated capacity and will not exceed more than 25 people at any given time. Reservation will highlight capacity of this reserved area.
 - a. Refundable damage/COVID-19 Contact Tracing deposit of \$100 required at time of reservation.
 - b. The Damage/COVID-19 Contact Tracing deposit will be refunded once the required Contact Tracing list of event attendees is returned to the Parks and Recreation Administrative Office, 800 Goodnight Avenue, Pueblo, CO 81005.
 - c. Two hour minimum @ \$100. Each additional hour, \$50 per hour due at time of reservation.
3. NO ALCOHOL. Deposit will be forfeited immediately.
4. All patrons will be required to maintain the “social distancing” requirement of 6-feet at all times.
5. It is recommended that all patrons utilizing the City Park Caboose Picnic Area shall wear masks.
6. Currently, The Rides at City Park are not in operation. Renter WILL NOT have access to The Rides at City Park.
7. NO BOUNCE HOUSES.
8. It is recommended that patrons bring their own sanitizing wipes and disinfect prior to utilizing tables and benches located within the Caboose area.

1. Avoid recreating in public spaces if anyone in your household is experiencing COVID-19 like symptoms.
2. Audience members must preregister to attend via Pueblo.us/movies (Civic Rec). Walk-ups are available, but they must stand in the standby line, and at 8:00 is the audience isn't capped at 175 they may take a seat, or earlier if there aren't 175 persons pre-registered.
3. Groups in attendance may not be larger than 8 people
4. Audience members will be asked to socially distance by sitting as a family on a dot that will be pre-marked on grass.
5. Attendees will not have to register with Pueblo Parks and Recreation for Pueblo West movies, they are in charge of the event we are just the contract service, invite those with questions to call Pueblo West Metro District.
6. All health department guidelines for Outdoor Gatherings apply
7. No more than 175 people in an outdoor setting which will be marked off.
8. Each group will be seated together and no groups larger than 8 may be seated together. Other groups will be at least 6 feet apart.
9. All staff will be required to wear masks. Participants will be strongly encouraged to wear masks.
10. City staff will sanitize restroom facilities multiple times throughout the evening.
11. Temperature check staff before shift. Temperatures of 100.4 or above, the individual will be asked to leave the facility.
12. Employees will be present to ensure that proper physical/social distancing protocol is enforced, announcements will be made every 20-minutes.
13. Discourage use of playground adjacent to movie showing area to prevent gathering.
14. Attendees will be required to pre-register via CivicRec at www.puebloparks.us to attend the movie showing.
15. If there is a confirmed case among the visitors or employees, the Movies Coordinator will notify and cooperate with the Pueblo Department of Public Health and Environment.
16. Avoid recreating in public spaces if anyone in your household is experiencing COVID-19 like symptoms.
17. Leave the facility as soon as reasonably possible. No extra-curricular or social activity should take place.

MITCHELL PARK POOL – Due to unforeseen issues with circulation system, this pool will not be opening as originally scheduled

PUBLIC SWIMMING SESSION CONDITIONS

1. Avoid recreating in public spaces if anyone in your household is experiencing COVID-19 like symptoms.
2. REVISED - Pool capacity will be reduced by up to 50% or ~~50~~-100 patrons, whichever is less.
 - a. City Park Pool Revised Capacity (not including staff): ~~50~~ 100
 - b. Mineral Palace Park Pool Revised Capacity (not including staff): ~~50~~ 100
 - c. Bessemer Park Pool Revised Capacity (not including staff): ~~50~~ 100
 - d. Mitchell Park Pool will not open due to leak in circulation system.
2. Run two public sessions per day, per public. (See schedule above)
3. All patrons will maintain the “social distancing” requirement of 6-feet at all times.
4. Immediate family members up to 10 can remain under the 6-foot distancing requirement with each other, but as a group will maintain “social distancing” of 6-feet.
5. If an emergency arises and pool must be cleared, all patrons will be required to exit the pool complex in order to maintain the 6-foot “social distancing” requirement.
6. Patrons waiting to enter the pool facilities will observe “social distancing” requirements of 6-feet or more. If capacity of the line exceeds the safe 6-foot spacing requirements, patrons will be asked to wait in their vehicles until the entry line becomes shorter.
7. All patrons will be required to wear a mask if not in the water.
8. Following our lightning policy, the pool must be cleared, and patrons will be required to exit the facility. Bathroom will be closed to patrons if this occurs. Recommended that patrons wait in their vehicle until the storm passes.

9. All deck lounge chairs will be removed. Picnic tables for family use only. Family consists of four (4) or more patrons from their immediate family and must include a parent/guardian.
10. Each facility will have a dedicated staff member responsible for enforcing the “social distancing” requirement of 6-feet. These staff members will also be responsible for disinfecting and sanitizing throughout each swim session.
11. No pool rentals, reservations, or afternoon birthday party rentals allowed.

WADING/BABY POOLS will be CLOSED.

SPRAY PADS at Bessemer Park and Mitchell Park Pools will be CLOSED

LAP SWIM SESSIONS

Same guidelines as listed for PUBLIC SWIMMING SESSIONS with the addition of the following:

1. Restrict to two (2) swimmers per lane. Must start at opposite ends of lane. **Revised 07/10/20**
2. Limit each lap swim session to 30 minutes to allow for rotation of swimmers awaiting their opportunity.
3. No spectators allowed in pool area.

WATER AEROBICS SESSIONS

Same guidelines as listed for PUBLIC SWIMMING SESSIONS with the addition of the following:

1. Limited to ~~50~~ 100 capacity (not including pool staff).
2. Instructor will remain on pool deck and monitor “social distancing” while teaching class.
3. Participants will be required to wear masks while out of the water.
4. No spectators allowed in pool area.

YMCA SWIM LESSONS

Same guidelines as listed for PUBLIC SWIMMING SESSIONS with the addition of the following:

1. No spectators allowed in pool area. See item #3 below.
2. All participants will need to shower before entering the pool and wash their hands with soap and water for 20 seconds. Parents in the Parent/Tot lessons and getting in the water with child will need to do this also.
3. Only one parent/guardian/caretaker brings child to lessons as only one will be allowed on the pool deck to help with capacity limits.
4. Social distancing requirements must be observed.
5. Child must wash their hands after their lesson is over. See item #2.
6. Masks are heavily encouraged for any spectators on the pool deck and all children over 2 years old.
7. Instructors will not be asked to wear a mask in the water, however they are required to wear a mask when out of the pool.
8. All instructors have been trained on social distancing in the pool with the participants and celebrating success by “water slaps” or elbow bumps instead of high fives.

SWIM CLUB PRACTICE

Same guidelines as listed for PUBLIC SWIMMING SESSIONS with the addition of the following:

1. Two (2) swimmers per lane. Must start on opposite ends of the lane. **Revised 07/10/20**
2. During equipment changes, swimmers must exit pool and follow all safety guidelines and “social distancing” requirements.
3. Markings on deck designating 6-foot spacing for swimmer’s equipment bags.
4. All swimmers bring own equipment, i.e.: goggles, caps, suit, and boards. No sharing equipment allowed.
5. No spectators allowed in pool area.

PADDLEBOARD YOGA

Same guidelines as listed for PUBLIC SWIMMING SESSIONS with the addition of the following:

1. Instructor will remain on pool deck and monitor “social distancing” while teaching class.
2. No spectators allowed in pool area.

3. Masks are optional.

SUMMER YOUTH SPORTS PROGRAMS *Groups of 25 or fewer*

T-BALL @ Stauter Field

1. Avoid recreating in public spaces if anyone in your household is experiencing COVID-19 like symptoms.
2. All staff, coaches, and spectators will be required to wear masks. Players will wear masks while not in game.
3. All staff, coaches, players and spectators will maintain the “social distancing” requirement of 6-feet at all times.
4. Dugouts will be closed. Players will be required to sit with their parents/guardians during their time for “at bat” outside the field area while maintaining the “social distancing” requirement of 6-feet.
5. Bleachers will be closed (or removed). Spectators must maintain the 6-foot spacing to stand or sit during their child’s game.
6. Warm-up areas for each team will be designated that highlight the “social distancing” requirement.
7. No traditional home plate meeting between coaches and captains prior to game.
8. Staff will handle all batting tees for the young players. No coaches or parents will be allowed to touch batting tees or balls.
9. No sharing of equipment (bats, helmets, etc.)
10. Batting helmets will be sanitized between innings of each game.
11. City staff will sanitize restroom facilities multiple times throughout the evening.
12. No team huddle before, during, or after game.
13. No handshaking/high-fives/fist-bumping before, during or after the game.
14. No seeds [spitting] allowed.
15. We suggest that all players/coaches/staff please use sanitizer before and after using any equipment.
16. Leave the facility as soon as reasonably possible. No extra-curricular or social activity should take place.

SUMMER BASKETBALL AT THE SLABS *Groups of 25 or fewer*

1. Avoid recreating in public spaces if anyone in your household is experiencing COVID-19 like symptoms.
2. All staff, coaches, and spectators will be required to wear masks. Players will wear masks while not in game.
3. All staff, coaches, players and spectators will maintain the “social distancing” requirement of 6-feet at all times.
4. Sanitize basketballs periodically during each game.
5. No team huddle before, during, or after game.
6. No handshaking/high-fives/fist-bumping before, during or after the game.
7. No seeds [spitting] allowed.
8. We suggest that all players/coaches/staff/spectators please use sanitizer before and after using any equipment.
9. Leave the facility as soon as reasonably possible. No extra-curricular or social activity should take place.

PARKS ATHLETIC LEAGUE (PAL) SUMMER YOUTH BASEBALL @ JOE SANTOS FIELD

(BESSEMER PARK) *Groups of 25 or fewer per field*

Program runs thru Thursday, 07/30

1. Avoid recreating in public spaces if anyone in your household is experiencing COVID-19 like symptoms.
2. All staff, participants, coaches, and spectators will be required to wear masks.
3. All staff, coaches, participants, and spectators will maintain the “social distancing” requirement of 6-feet at all times.
4. Dugouts will be closed. Participants will be required to sit outside the field area while maintaining the 6-foot social distancing requirement.
5. Staff will sanitize baseballs, bats, and batting helmets periodically throughout the program session.
6. No team huddle before, during, or after game.
7. No handshaking/high-fives/fist-bumping before, during or after the game.
8. No seeds [spitting] allowed.
9. Leave the facility as soon as reasonably possible. No extra-curricular or social activity should take place.

SUMMER ADULT SPORTS PROGRAMS

CO-ED & MEN'S LEAGUE SOFTBALL @ City Park Field #3 & #4 *Groups of 25 or fewer per field*

Games run thru Thursday, 08/27, or 09/3

1. Avoid recreating in public spaces if anyone in your household is experiencing COVID-19 like symptoms.
2. All staff, umpires, coaches, and spectators will be required to wear masks. Players will wear masks while not in game. No spectators strongly encouraged.
3. All staff, coaches, players, and spectators will maintain the "social distancing" requirement of 6-feet at all times.
4. Dugouts will be closed. Players will be outside the field area while maintaining the "social distancing" requirement of 6-feet.
5. Bleachers will be closed (or removed). No spectators strongly encouraged.
6. Warm-up areas for each team will be designated that highlight the "social distancing" requirement.
7. No traditional home plate meeting between coaches and captains prior to game.
8. No sharing of equipment (bats, gloves, etc.)
9. No team huddle before, during, or after game.
10. No handshaking/high-fives/fist-bumping before, during or after the game.
11. No seeds [spitting] allowed.
12. We suggest that all players/coaches/staff/umpires please use sanitizer before and after using any equipment.
13. Leave the facility as soon as reasonably possible. No extra-curricular or social activity should take place.
14. NO TOURNAMENTS!

PARK BENCH TREATS CONCESSIONS

City Park Concessions (near City Park Playground): Open daily, 11am to 9pm

City Park Pool: Open daily 12 to 5:30pm thru 08/16 and during special extended weekend of 08/21 thru 08/23

Bessemer Park Pool: Open daily, 12 to 5:30pm daily thru 08/16

Mineral Palace Park Pool: Open daily, 12 to 5:30pm daily thru 08/16

1. Customers will be limited to walk-up window service.
2. All concession staff are required to frequently wash hands while on duty.
3. All concession staff will be required to wear masks and gloves.
4. All concession staff will have temperature checks taken prior to entering the facility. If temperature is 100.4 or higher, they will not be allowed to work and will be sent home.
5. All concession staff and customers will maintain the "social distancing" requirement of 6-feet at all times. Markings and signage will designate the 6-foot "social distance" for customers waiting in line at concession sites.
6. Cleaning practices will be elevated and frequency increased, including disinfection of high-touch point areas.
7. All menus will be posted or on-line only.
8. All concession areas will provide single-use or single serving condiments only.
9. All concession staff will be required to take home all belongings, including water bottles, after every shift.
10. Concession staff will conduct daily disinfection and full cleaning in-between shifts in accordance with CDPHE guidelines.
11. All picnic tables will be limited use per the 6-foot "social distancing" requirement. Staff will elevate and increase frequency cleaning of tables.
12. Signage will be posted for employees and patrons reminding them of good hygiene and other sanitation practices.
13. Designated pick-up waiting areas will be clearly marked for proper distancing between parties.
14. Concession staff will make every effort to reduce congregation around the outdoor concession sites with clearly marked entrance and exit locations.
15. Provide contactless payment options whenever possible at all concession sites.
16. Minimize objects touched by multiple patrons including moving to single touch packets.
17. Disinfect any shared objects such as POS machines thoroughly between uses.
18. Provide hand sanitizer at check-in area and throughout the concession area.

1. Avoid recreating in public spaces if anyone in your household is experiencing COVID-19 like symptoms.
2. Group size shall be no larger than five (5) players per court. No spectators strongly encouraged.
3. Doubles play is allowed.
4. All players/spectators will maintain the “social distancing” requirement of 6-feet at all times.
5. All players/spectators utilizing the facility are strongly encouraged to wear masks.
6. All benches and picnic tables will be limited use per the 6-foot social distancing requirement.
7. All players/spectators are encouraged to frequently wash hands. If soap and water are not available, bring their own hand hygiene supplies (hand sanitizer). Players shall practice “self-sanitizing” of their equipment (balls and racquets) to assist in maintaining the sanitization of the facility.
8. City staff will sanitize all gate latches and court furniture multiple times throughout the day.
9. City staff will sanitize restroom facilities multiple times throughout the day.
10. Each opponent proceeds play with their own tennis balls. Do not share tennis balls or racquets.
11. Tennis lessons will be limited to only 5 students per class instructor, per court.
12. No tournaments or leagues allowed at this time.
13. Leave the court as soon as reasonably possible. No extra-curricular or social activity should take place. All players should leave the facility immediately after play.

OUTDOOR BASKETBALL COURTS

1. Avoid recreating in public spaces if anyone in your household is experiencing COVID-19 like symptoms.
2. Group size shall be no larger than ten (10) players per court. Spectators strongly discouraged.
3. Games where “social distancing” cannot be maintained are not permitted.
4. All patrons utilizing the facility are encouraged to wear a mask.
5. All patrons will maintain the “social distancing” requirement of 6-feet at all times.
6. Leave the court as soon as reasonably possible. No extra-curricular or social activity should take place. All players should leave the facility immediately after play.

CITY PARK DOG PARK

1. Avoid recreating in public spaces if anyone in your household is experiencing COVID-19 like symptoms.
2. Maximum dog owners occupying the large dog section of the dog park will not exceed 25.
3. Maximum dog owners occupying the small dog section of the dog park will not exceed 10.
4. Please limit your visit to the dog park to 30-minutes or less per dog owner. This is to allow others waiting the opportunity.
5. All patrons utilizing the facility shall always wear masks.
6. All patrons will maintain the “social distancing” requirement of 6-feet at all times.
7. It is recommended that patrons bring their own sanitizing wipes and disinfect prior to utilizing tables and benches located within the dog park.
8. City staff will sanitize dog water fountains and gate latches when cleaning restrooms.
9. No personal water dishes allowed.
10. All dog toys left behind will be discarded.
11. Leave the dog park as soon as reasonably possible. No extra-curricular or social activity should take place. All patrons should leave the facility immediately after their 30-minute period expires.

PLAYGROUNDS & EXERCISE EQUIPMENT

1. Avoid recreating in public spaces if anyone in your household is experiencing COVID-19 like symptoms.
2. All patrons utilizing the facility are encouraged to wear a mask.
3. All patrons will maintain the “social distancing” requirement of 6-feet at all times.
4. Suggested 45-minute time limit on playground. This is to allow others waiting the opportunity.
5. All benches and picnic tables will be limited use per the 6-foot social distancing requirement.
6. We suggest that all playground users please use sanitizer before and after using the equipment.
7. Avoid recreating in public spaces if anyone in your household is experiencing COVID-19 like symptoms.
8. Leave the playground area as soon as reasonably possible. No extra-curricular or social activity should take place. All patrons should leave the facility immediately after their playground visit.

DISC GOLF COURSE

1. Group size per hole shall be no larger than five (5) players/spectators.
2. All players/spectators utilizing the facility shall always wear masks.
3. All players/spectators will maintain the “social distancing” requirement of 6-feet at all times.
4. Baskets shall be removed, so players are not required to touch any part of the basket to retrieve their disc.
5. Players will not share equipment.
6. Players shall practice self-sanitizing by cleaning their equipment as needed.
7. No tournaments or leagues allowed at this time.
8. Upon finishing their round, players/spectators must leave the course. No loitering on the course or parking area.

HORSESHOE PITS AND BOCCE BALL COURT

1. Group size shall be no larger than five (5) players/spectators.
2. All players/spectators utilizing the facility shall always wear gloves and masks.
3. All players/spectators will maintain the “social distancing” requirement of 6-feet at all times.
4. All benches and picnic tables will be limited use per the 6-foot social distancing requirement.
5. Players will not share equipment.
6. Players shall practice self-sanitizing by cleaning their equipment as needed.
7. No tournaments or leagues allowed at this time.
8. Upon finishing, players/spectators must leave the facility. No loitering in the court or parking area.

SKATE PARKS

1. All skaters/spectators utilizing the facility shall always wear masks.
2. All skaters/spectators will maintain the “social distancing” requirement of 6-feet at all times.
3. City staff will sanitize periodically throughout the day. It is recommended that users assist by sanitizing areas of facility as they use the park.
4. Upon finishing, facility users and spectators must leave the facility. No loitering in the park or skating area.
