Suspicious Death on Union Avenue

August 30, 2020 [FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE]



On August 30, 2020 at approximately 6:50 p.m., Pueblo police officers responded to the 200 block of South Union Avenue regarding a dead body. A female had located a deceased male behind a vacant building at the corner of Union Avenue and “D” Street and reported such to the police department.

Officers arrived and located the deceased male. Suspicious circumstances at the scene prompted the officers to summon the detectives from the Crimes Against Persons Section, who responded and initiated an investigation. As of the drafting of this press release, detectives are considering this incident a suspicious death.

The identity of the deceased male will be released by the Pueblo County Coroner’s Office pending notification of next-of-kin.
