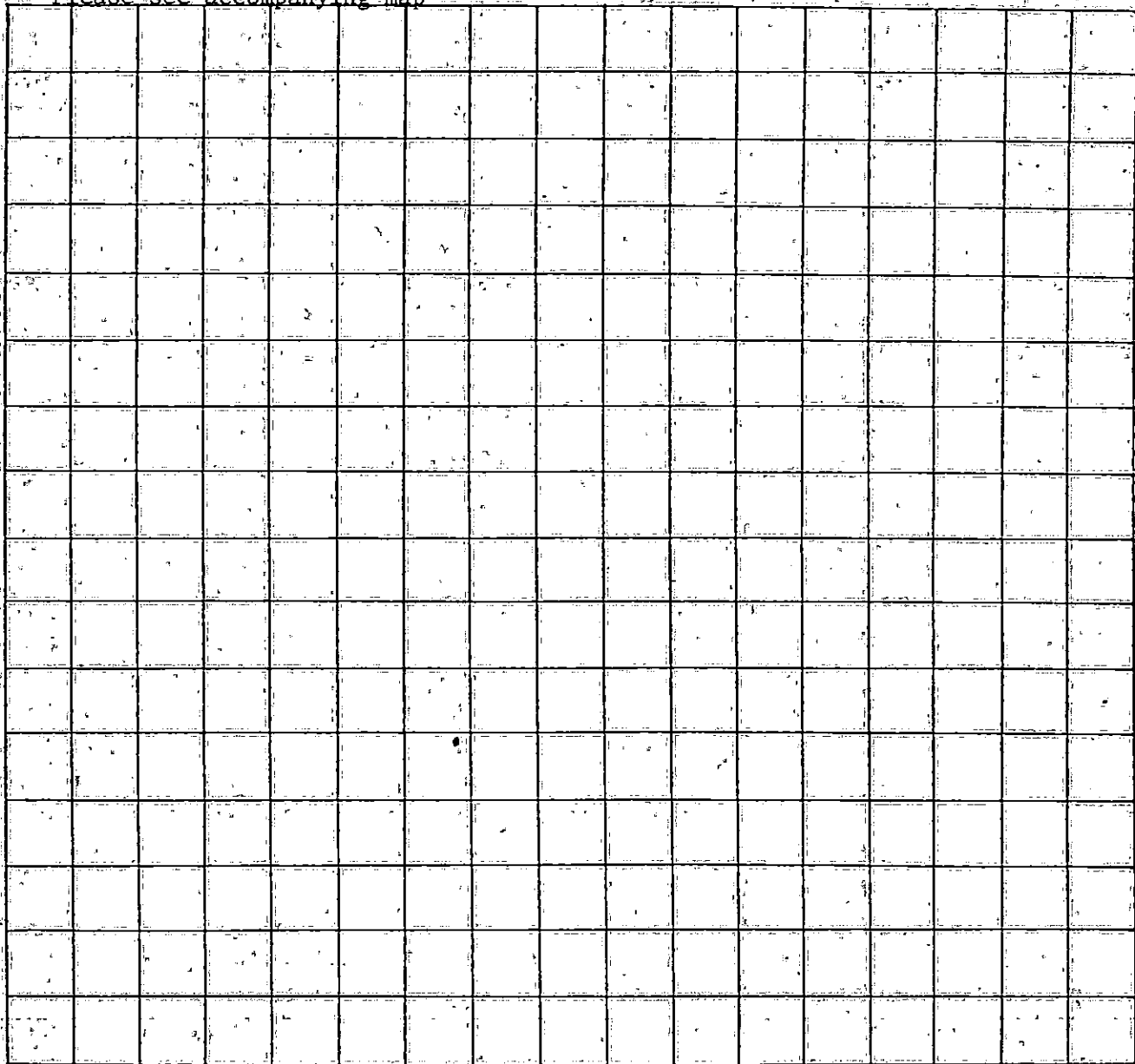

EAST MESA--RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT

The East Mesa District is generally bounded by Northern Avenue on the south, the property line to the east of Russ and School Avenues on the east, the alley north of Arroyo Avenue and East Mesa Avenue on the north, and the railroad tracks and South Santa Fe Avenue on the west. This district contains three subdivisions. City Hall Place 2nd Filing was recorded in 1901, Wein and Agram was recorded in 1901, and Liabach Subdivision was recorded in 1917. Structures within this area reflect the time periods within which the areas were subdivided. The residential development between East Mesa and East Northern is characterized as small lot high density development with a small front yard setback. The residential development in the Liabach Subdivision is on larger lots and the area contains a number of Bungalows. The East Mesa District has strong Bohemian associations. This neighborhood was developed between CF&I and the Eilers Smelter. It was designed to provide housing for mill and smelter workers. This area was first mapped by the Sanborn Insurance Company in 1904.
