Homicide

On Wednesday, February 3, 2021 at approximately 7:21 p.m., the Pueblo Police Department received a report of a male lying in the intersection of City Center Drive and Chester Avenue.

Upon arrival, officers located the male laying in the driveway of a local business in the 400 block of E. City Center Drive. The male had sustained nondescript injuries and was deceased.

The preliminary investigation revealed that the male, a homeless man who was known to reside along the Fountain Creek, was wounded and walking westbound on City Center Drive. The victim collapsed and died in the aforementioned driveway.

Detectives are currently investigating this incident as a homicide. An autopsy will be performed and the Pueblo County Coroner will determine the victim's cause of death. There is no suspect information available as of the drafting of this press release.

The identity of the victim will be released by the Pueblo County Coroner's Office.
