The Southern Colorado Safe Streets Task Force is attempting to locate two wanted street criminals.

Carlos Montoya (47) is described as a Hispanic male, 5'04", 220 pounds, with black hair and brown eyes. Montoya has a no bond warrant for Bail Secured Bond-Flight to Avoid which includes: Violation of Bail Bond Conditions, Violation of a Protection Order, Driving Under Restraint and Divided Highway-Drove Wrong Side. He has a second no bond warrant for Contempt of Court-Property Damage which includes Criminal Mischief.

Albert Ayala (39) is described as a Hispanic male, 6'00", 185 pounds, with brown hair and brown eyes. Ayala has a no bond warrant for Assault. He has a second warrant for Failure to Appear which includes Speeding 25-39, 37 Miles Over the Limit and Driving Under Restraint. His total bond amount is \$1,000.
