On February 10, 2021 at approximately 12:04 p.m., Pueblo police officers responded to a bank robbery at Pueblo Bank and Trust located 2127 Jerry Murphy Road. A suspect entered the bank and passed a note demanding money. The suspect is described as a tall, slender male, wearing a black hat with an unknown emblem, dark sunglasses, black mask, black jacket, black gloves, black pants, black sandals with black socks. The suspect left the bank with an undisclosed amount of cash in an unknown direction.
