City of Pueblo Police Department Weekly Safe Streets Wanted Criminal Round-Up

The Southern Colorado Safe Streets Task Force is attempting to locate two wanted street criminals.

Emanuel Gallegos (26) is described as a Hispanic male, 6'01", 195 pounds, with brown hair and brown eyes. Gallegos has a no bond warrant for Flight-Escape which includes Burglary and a no bond warrant for Motor Vehicle Theft.

Marissa Smith (22) is described as a White female, 5'08", 155 pounds, with brown hair and blue eyes. Smith has a total of six warrants. She has a no bond warrant for Assault. A warrant for Failure to Comply and four warrants for Failure to Appear which include the following charges: Assault, Burglary, Violation of a Protection Order, Larceny, Driving Under Restraint, Failure to Display Proof of Insurance and Seatbelt-Not Used. Her total bond amount is \$25,501.
