Structure Fire

On Saturday, March 13, 2021, the Pueblo Police Department responded to a structure fire in the 1200 block of W. 15th Street. The residence was fully engulfed in fire and smoke. Pueblo Fire Department personnel arrived to fight the fire with several resources.

Two people were transported to an area hospital for medical treatment for fire related injuries. Both individuals suffered critical injuries. Police and Fire later located two deceased persons in the basement of the house. These individuals will be identified by the Pueblo County Coroner's Office at the appropriate time. The Pueblo Police Department is investigating the circumstances of this fire.
