On April 13, 2021 at approximately 9:15 a.m, a male entered the Power Credit Union (1615 E Evans Ave) and produced a note to a teller that they were being robbed. No weapon was seen. The suspect left the area in a silver 2-door car.

The suspect was described as skinny build, 6 foot, wearing a yellow construction helmet, orange reflective vest, black pants, black shoes, white long sleeve white shirt, red gloves, and wearing a gray gator neck that covered his nose and mouth. They stated he was a "younger" male and had short blonde hair.

Witnesses described the car as a silver 4-door, unknown plate on the vehicle.
