**Homicide Update**



May 3, 2021 [FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE]



On Sunday, May 2, 2021 at approximately 2:45 a.m., Pueblo police responded to the 1000 block of Berkley Avenue regarding a shooting. A deceased male victim was discovered who had sustained an apparent gunshot wound to his chest. Pueblo police detectives initiated an investigation and identified the suspect as 28-year-old Kevin Woodard. Woodard now has an active arrest warrant for First Degree Murder in connection with this homicide. He is described as a White male, 6'2" tall and 230 lbs, with brown eyes and balding hair. He has small tattoos above his eyebrows. Woodard should be considered ARMED AND DANGEROUS. If you see Woodard, do not attempt to apprehend him. Rather, contact the nearest law enforcement agency.

Woodard may be in the company of 30-year-old Samantha Shields (pictured above). Shields is described as a White female, 5'4" tall and 120 lbs, with brown hair and green eyes.
