On May 10, 2021 at approximately 4:23 a.m., Pueblo police officers were dispatched to a motorcycle accident on westbound Highway 50 Bypass above I-25. Pueblo police also received a call of shots fired near the intersection of Hudson Ave. and Highway 50 Bypass about the same time.

Pueblo police determined there was no motorcycle accident. The male victim (motorcycle rider) had been shot. The victim received medical attention but was pronounced deceased on scene. Pueblo police closed the roadway and processed the scene. This case is being investigated as a homicide. There have been nine homicides in the City of Pueblo in 2021.

The identity of the victim will be released by the Pueblo County Coroner's Office pending notification of next-of-kin.
