UPDATE: Request for Public's Assistance in Shooting Investigation

June 9, 2021 [FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE]

After the Pueblo Police Department announced Esteban Gallegos as a suspect in this case, new information was discovered that ruled Mr. Gallegos out as the shooter. The arrest warrant that was issued for Mr. Gallegos related to this incident has been cleared and the Pueblo Police Department is no longer looking for him.

Detectives have recovered the vehicle involved in this incident and are asking the community for help in locating the owner, 41-year-old Tonya Albach-Ortega. Albach-Ortega is described as a White female, 5'01", 178lbs. with brown hair and hazel eyes.
