Safe Streets Fugitive Arrested

On June 17, 2021 at approximately 5:15 p.m., a detective assigned to the Pueblo Police Department's Criminal Information Section observed a vehicle with no license plates pull into an apartment complex in the 1900 block of W. 13th Street. The detective was familiar with the vehicle as one having been previously reported as stolen. The vehicle parked, at which time a female passenger exited and entered an apartment. Several minutes later the detective observed a known wanted fugitive, 27-year-old Danny Garcia, exit the vehicle from the driver's side and enter the same apartment. Detectives maintained surveillance on the apartment for an extended period until the female reappeared and attempted to get back into the vehicle. The female was stopped by a detective and she confirmed that Garcia was in the apartment. At this time announcements were given by the detectives for the occupants of the apartment to exit, and Garcia was taken into custody without incident.

Garcia was arrested on seven active warrants. A search warrant was authored for, and executed upon, the apartment. Three firearms and suspected narcotics were seized. Additional charges are pending.

Garcia was featured by the Pueblo Police Department in May of 2021 as a Safe Streets Wanted Criminal. As an adult, Garcia has been arrested ten times by the Pueblo PD.
