Homicide Arrest Warrant

On Thursday, August 19, 2021, at approximately 10:17 p.m., the Pueblo Police Department received a 9-1-1 call indicating someone had been shot in the 1700 block of Troy Ave.

Police found an adult male victim on scene. The victim was pronounced deceased on scene. The victim was identified by the Pueblo County Coroner as 36-year-old, Mack James Glover. Pueblo Police are looking for a 2014 White Dodge Charger with Colorado plates BFHD90 in the case.

Pueblo police obtained a 1st degree Murder arrest warrant for 33-year-old, Mathew James Archuletta. Archuletta is a Hispanic male, 5'7", 228 lbs., Brown Hair, Brown eyes. Archuletta was a 2018 Southern Colorado Safe Streets Task Force wanted criminal.
