On August 24, 2021 at approximately 7:00 p.m., Pueblo police responded to the south side Walmart regarding an auto/pedestrian hit-and-run accident that occurred in the parking lot. The investigation revealed that the victim, an adult male, was exiting Walmart on foot and walking through the crosswalk when he was struck by a vehicle that was traveling through the parking lot. The vehicle continued without stopping and left Walmart. The victim received minor injuries.

A short time later, the suspect vehicle was involved in another hit-and-run accident at Pueblo Boulevard and Elmwood Circle. The second hit-and-run accident involved a vehicle, not a pedestrian.

The suspect is described as a Black male with dreadlocks. The suspect vehicle is a silver Jeep Commander with no license plates. The suspect vehicle should have body damage as a result of the second hit-and-run accident.
