## Fugitives Arrested at Val-U-Stay Inn and Suites

On September 8, 2021 at approximately 2:30 p.m., Pueblo police detectives responded to Val-U-Stay Inn and Suites located at 2001 N. Hudson Avenue regarding an attempt to locate wanted fugitives. The detectives had received information that parole fugitives Kyle Evans (29 years old) and Mariah Montano (30 years old) were staying in a room at this location.

One of the detectives observed Evans exit the room and walk to the front of the hotel where he was arrested on his active felony parole violation warrant. A short time later, another detective contacted Montano at the hotel room and took her into custody for her active felony parole violation warrant.

As the detective was arresting Montano, he saw two other males in the hotel room. One of the males was 36-year-old Maurice Burt and the other was a juvenile. Both males lied about their identities. They were each soon identified, however, and Burt was confirmed to have two active misdemeanor arrest warrants (Assault/Domestic Violence and Violation of Restraining Order). The juvenile had three active felony arrest warrants (Assault/Assault/Fraud-Handgun) and two misdemeanor arrest warrants (Assault). The juvenile was also discovered to be in possession of 2.76 pounds of Marijuana that was individually packaged for distribution, as well as a scale and currency. Additionally, the juvenile had in his possession several spent shell casings of various calibers.

The three adult parties were arrested on their warrants and booked into the Pueblo County Detention Center. Burt was also booked on the new charges of Violation of Restraining Order and Criminal Impersonation. The juvenile was taken into custody and booked into Pueblo Youth Services Center on his five outstanding warrants. The juvenile was also booked on the new charges of Possession of Marijuana with Intent to Distribute, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and Criminal Impersonation.

Evans and Montano were featured as Southern Colorado FBI Safe Streets Most Wanted Criminals. Evans has been arrested 34 times by the Pueblo PD. Montano has been arrested 12 times by the Pueblo PD. Burt has been arrested 26 times by the Pueblo PD.
