Shooting



September 20, 2021 [FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE]

On Friday, September 17, 2021 at approximately 9:02 p.m., Pueblo police were dispatched to the area of 1-100 block of Oxford Street regarding a report of a shooting. The 9-1-1 caller stated there was a male at this address who had just been shot. Upon arrival officers contacted an adult male who had been shot multiple times. Officers immediately applied tourniquets to his injuries until fire/rescue arrived.

Officers conducted an investigation and learned the victim heard someone knocking on his front door and ringing his doorbell. There were three males with face coverings standing outside the door. The victim armed himself with a handgun and told the unknown males to leave. One of the unknown males outside his door began to shoot through the closed door and struck the victim. The suspects fled the area after the shooting.

The victim had no information on his attackers and could not think of any reason for his home to be targeted. The victim was treated at local area hospital. His injuries were considered serious bodily injury. The victim is in stable condition.
