On Wednesday, September 29, 2021 at approximately 12:03 p.m., a Pueblo police officer was driving on Indiana Avenue when he noticed a male who was face down on the sidewalk in the 2100 block of Wyoming Avenue. As the officer turned around to investigate, dispatch aired a shooting had just occurred in the 2100 block of Wyoming Avenue with multiple victims.

The police officer rendered emergency medical attention to an adult male gunshot victim (Victim #1). The officer applied a tourniquet to Victim #1 before he was transported to an area hospital via ambulance with critical injuries. Victim #1 later died at the hospital despite medical attention. His identity will be released by the Pueblo County Coroner's Office when appropriate notifications have been made.

A second gunshot victim (Victim #2), also an adult male, was walking to an area hospital as the officer arrived on scene and tended to Victim #1. A citizen assisted by picking up Victim #2 and transporting him to the area hospital. He was listed as being in critical condition.

Officers were involved in a vehicle pursuit and a foot pursuit involving possible suspects from the shooting. The 2400 block of Lake Avenue was closed as officers attempted to locate the party who fled on foot. Neither of those individuals were located or apprehended.

Detectives with the Pueblo Police Department's Crimes Against Persons Section are investigating this case as a homicide.
