The Southern Colorado Safe Streets Task Force is attempting to locate two wanted street criminals.

Nicholas Tumblin (31) is described as a White male, 6'01", 210 pounds, with brown hair and blue eyes. Tumblin has a no bond warrant for Homicide and a no bond warrant for Attempted Homicide. He has a third no bond warrant for a Parole Violation which includes: Aggravated Robbery, Robbery, Aggravated Motor Vehicle Theft, Attempted Escape, Possession of a Controlled Substance, Vehicular Eluding, Smuggle Contraband, Flight Escape and Attempted Theft.

Danny Garcia (28), who was previously featured on Safe Streets May 07, 2021, is described as a Hispanic male, 5'11", 160 pounds, with black hair and brown eyes. Garcia has two warrants for Failure to appear which includes: Dangerous Drugs x2, Possession of a Controlled Substance x2, Illegal Weapon - Possession, Driving Under the Influence x2, No Insurance – Driver, Driving Without a License, Driving Under Restraint, and Registration Fictitious Plate. His total bond amount is \$7,000.
