## Homicide Update

Homicide suspect, 36-year-old Andrew Baros, turned himself in to the Pueblo County Detention Center on October 6, 2021 on charges of 1<sup>st</sup> Degree Murder and Attempted 1<sup>st</sup> Degree Murder.

This investigation is from the Wednesday, September 29, 2021 shooting that occurred in the 2100 block of Wyoming Avenue. The shooting resulted in the death of 37-year-old Carlos Lerma. A second adult male gunshot victim was hospitalized and was last listed as being in stable condition. That victim remains in the hospital.
