## Attempted Homicide

On October 6, 2021 Pueblo Police were dispatched to the 2007 block of Belmont on a shots fired call. The victim indicated that his neighbor, later identified as 30-year-old, Cody Provost arrived at his trailer, shot the front door several times and attempted to kick in the door. Provost walked to the front of the trailer and shot several more times through the window.

Prior to leaving the area Provost told someone he was "going to get more guns". Officers checked several locations looking for Provost. The vehicle that Provost left the area in was located in the 1900 block of Toronto Street. A handgun believed to be used in the shooting was recovered.

Provost was later contacted in the 1900 block of Toronto Street and arrested for Attempted 1<sup>st</sup> Degree Murder.
