## Homicide/Shooting

On Thursday, October 7, 2021 at approximately 10:48 p.m., Pueblo police officers were on a call near the area of 1100 block of E. 4th St. While on that call, officers aired they heard multiple shots near the area. Officers canvassed the area and located two males with gunshot wounds in the alley north of the 900 block of E. 3rd Street.

One male was transported to a local hospital with multiple gunshot wounds. The second male succumbed to his injuries on scene.

Detectives from the Pueblo Police Department's Crimes Against Persons Section responded and initiated an investigation into the incident. As of the drafting of this press release, no arrests have been made.
