Suspect Arrested

On October 18, 2021 at approximately 2:10 p.m., a Pueblo police officer responded to the Walmart store located at 4200 Dillon Drive regarding a report of an indecent exposure. The victim reported that a male was following her around the store and trying to look up her dress as he fondled himself. He left the store when she confronted him. Loss prevention personnel were made aware of the incident, and they were able to track the male until he boarded a city bus.

The investigating officer responded to the city bus transfer station located at 123 Court Street, where he was able to take the suspect into custody shortly after he (the suspect) exited a bus. The suspect initially provided a false name, but he was eventually identified as 38-year-old Robert Locey. He had active arrest warrants out of three other states, including a warrant for Failure to Register as a Sex Offender out of Tennessee, but none of warrants were extraditable from Colorado.

Locey was booked into the Pueblo County Detention Center on the charges of Harassment, Criminal Impersonation and Failure to Register as a Sex Offender.
