Fatal Traffic Collision

On Sunday, October 24, 2021 at approximately 10:44 p.m., Pueblo police were dispatched to I-25 southbound, just south of the Pueblo Boulevard on-ramp on a report of a single car traffic collision.

When officers arrived on scene, a trooper from the Colorado State Patrol was removing the victim from the wreckage. The vehicle was on fire as a result of the collision. Despite medical attention on scene, the driver was declared deceased. The victim will be identified by the Pueblo County Coroner.

Preliminary investigation revealed the vehicle ran off the right side of the roadway, collided with a metal light pole, and then continued travelling until it struck a tree. The Pueblo Police Department Traffic Section and Identification Section are conducting this investigation.

The information contained in this press release is based on preliminary information available at the time of its drafting. The Pueblo Police Department's understanding of this incident may change as additional evidence is collected, analyzed and reviewed.
