On Sunday, October 31, 2021 at approximately 4:05 p.m., the Pueblo Police Department received a call requesting that officers check the welfare of an adult female at a residence in the 1700 block of Van Buren Street.

Upon the officers' arrival, they found the female deceased in the home. Based on evidence discovered at the scene, detectives responded and initiated a homicide investigation. There have been no arrests made as of the drafting of this press release.

The victim's identity will be released by the Pueblo County Coroner's Office.
