


Rescission of Covid-19 New Hire Vaccination Order

1. On November 10, 2021, I entered an order pursuant to the Pueblo City Charter Section 4-2, 4-3 and Civil Service Rule 12, requiring that all appointments of new employees for the City of Pueblo and Pueblo Transit were subject to and conditioned upon such employees being vaccinated against Covid-19 or having a qualifying exemption.
2. Pueblo County infection numbers have declined, more individuals have been fully vaccinated and the number of Covid-19 patients in our local hospitals have stabilized.
3. Mask mandates and other precautionary orders have been rescinded.

Effective at 8 am on May 11, 2022, the order previously entered, referred to above, is rescinded and it is no longer mandated that new employees be vaccinated against Covid-19. Notwithstanding the rescission of the order, it is recommended that every individual be vaccinated and boosted to protect themselves. Should there be another significant rise in any variation of the Covid-19 virus, it is possible that this order could be reinstated.
