





Drug Distribution Arrest

On Tuesday, December 21, 2021, Pueblo Police detectives from the Criminal Intelligence Section (CIS) were conducting surveillance on 35-year-old, Kevin Nagl. Detectives had information that Nagl was involved in criminal activity and not abiding by his parole agreement.

Nagl is a seven-time, multi-state convicted felon and was recently paroled on November 23, 2021. Nagl has felony convictions for Burglary, Theft x2, Menacing, Eluding x2, and Possession of a Weapon by Previous Offender. He was featured twice on the FBI Safe Streets Program and has been arrested by Pueblo Police 14 times as an adult.

Nagl was contacted in the 800 block of E. 4th St. with the assistance of parole officers. Detectives found one pound of suspected methamphetamine, a small amount of suspected heroin, and \$500 in cash in Nagl's backpack.

Nagl was arrested and booked into Pueblo County Detention Center for Possession with Intent to Distribute - Schedule I (methamphetamine), Driving Under Restraint, Fictitious Plates, and placed on a parole hold.
