On Friday, January 14, 2022, at approximately 8:00 p.m., Pueblo police were dispatched to Dollar General (818 E. 4th St.) on a shooting. Officers arrived on scene and located an adult female gunshot victim deceased on scene.

The suspect chased the victim from the parking lot into the store while he was shooting at her. The suspect appeared to have targeted the victim. The suspect is described as a muscular White or Hispanic male last seen wearing dark gray jacket, dark gray baseball hat, red undershirt, gray shoes with white trim on bottom.

Detectives with the Pueblo Police Department's Crimes Against Persons Section are investigating this case as a homicide. Detectives are following up on several active leads.

The victim's identity will be released by the Pueblo County Coroner's Office when appropriate notifications have been made.
