## Bank Robbery-Wanted Person

On Friday, January 21, 2022 at approximately 2:47 p.m., Pueblo Police were dispatched to 1715 S Pueblo Boulevard (Sunflower Bank) on reports of a bank alarm. The suspect was described as a Hispanic male, short, with a slender build.

The suspect gave the clerk a note demanding money. The male had a bulge in the waistline of his pants that implied he had a weapon; no weapon was seen. The suspect fled the scene with an undisclosed amount of cash. Police believe the suspect fled the scene in a black / brown spray-painted Toyota Four Runner.

Due to an alert patrol officer, Pueblo Police were able to identify the suspect as 31-year-old, Larry Chavez. There is an active arrest warrant for Chavez for this bank robbery. Police are looking for Chavez and the black / brown spray-painted Toyota Four Runner. Attached is an old picture of Chavez.
