





Traffic Fatality

On Saturday, January 29, 2022 at approximately 12:20 a.m., Pueblo police responded to the 400 block of I-25 southbound regarding a traffic collision with unknown injuries. Pueblo Police found an adult male had been ejected from the vehicle.

The male was transported to an area hospital. The male later died as a result of his injuries. The driver will be identified by the Pueblo County coroner when appropriate notifications have been made.

Preliminary information from this collision is that the driver was ejected from the vehicle after colliding with the guardrail and then struck by an unknown vehicle. Pueblo police are looking for any information or potential witnesses regarding this collision. Alcohol is believed to be a factor in the original collision.
