City of Pueblo Police Department Weekly Safe Streets Wanted Criminal Round-Up

The Southern Colorado Safe Streets Task Force is attempting to locate two wanted street criminals.

Daniel Howard (23) is described as a Hispanic male, 5'08", 175 pounds, with black hair and brown eyes. Howard has a no bond warrant for Homicide – Murder 1 - Extreme Indifference which includes Firearm - Illegal Discharge, Weapon – Prohibited Use – Aim Firearm, Reckless Endangerment.

Brandon Black (32) is described as a White male, 5'08", 130 pounds, with brown hair and brown eyes. Black has a no bond warrant for a Parole Violation which includes Vehicle Theft. He has a second warrant for Failure to Appear which includes the following charges: Traffic Offense, Violation of a Protection Order, Child Abuse – Negligently Cause Bodily Injury Added Count, Driving Under Restraint, Leaving the Scene of an Accident Involving Injury, No Insurance – Driver, Failing to Report Accident – Call Police, Careless Driving and Failure to Obey Traffic Control Device. His total bond amount is \$10,000.
