Aggravated Robbery Arrest

February 4, 2022 [FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE]



On Thursday February 3, 2022. Pueblo Police received information that 24-year-old, Jacob Villalobos was in the area of the 1000 block of E. 1st St. Villalobos was wanted for several robberies in the city of Pueblo in addition to a Parole Violation. Villalobos exited the residence and after a brief foot chase was taken into custody.

Villalobos was booked into Pueblo County Detention Center on Aggravated Robbery x2, Felony Menacing, Violation of Bond Conditions, Failure to Appear -Trespass, Resisting Arrest and a Parole Hold. Additional charges against Villalobos are pending.

Villalobos is a convicted felon, FBI Safe Streets Criminal, with several robbery charges on his Pueblo Police record.

The information contained in this press release is based on preliminary information available at the time of its drafting. The Pueblo Police Department's understanding of this incident may change as additional evidence is collected, analyzed and reviewed.
