Motor Vehicle Theft Arrest

On Sunday, February 27, 2022, at approximately 2:24 p.m., A Pueblo Police officer observed a black Jeep Wrangler in the 2000 block of Hudson Avenue that was seen in several neighborhoods committing thefts from autos.

Officers confirmed the vehicle was stolen and contacted the driver. The driver was later identified as 24-year-old, Gumaro Isaac Acosta. After a short struggle with officers Acosta was arrested. Gumaro was arrested on charges of Aggravated Motor Vehicle Theft, Identify Theft, 1st Degree Criminal Trespass, Resisting Arrest.

Acosta has previous involvements with the Pueblo Police Department to include Theft, Possession of a Controlled Substance, 3rd Degree Assault, Aggravated Motor Vehicle Theft 2x, Kidnapping, and Menacing.
