## Shooting

March 23, 2022



On Wednesday, March 23 at approximately 3:25am, Pueblo Police Officers were dispatched to the 4700 block of Eagleridge Circle on a report of a shooting.

Upon arrival, officers located a female in the parking lot with multiple gunshot wounds. During preliminary investigation, it was found the female, allegedly, was breaking into vehicles in the parking lot when the male shot at her. Other people were involved with the car break-ins but fled the scene prior to officers arriving.

The female was transported to a local hospital with life threatening injuries.

Officers took the suspect into custody on scene, without incident. He was transported to Pueblo Judicial Center and booked in on charges of 1<sup>st</sup> Degree Assault.

Detectives are seeking additional information regarding other people that fled the scene, prior to officers arriving.
