On Friday, April 15, 2022, at approximately 6:56 p.m., Pueblo Police were sent to the 600 block of E. 3rd St. on a shooting. Pueblo police arrived to find an adult male who appeared to be shot. The male victim was deceased on scene.

Pueblo Police crimes against persons detectives and crime scene investigations unit are on scene investigating this death. The victim in this incident will be identified by the Pueblo County Coroner after appropriate notifications. This is the sixth homicide in the City of Pueblo for 2022.

Pueblo police are looking for 32-year-old, Jessica Ann Apodaca as a person of interest in this homicide. She is described as a Hispanic female, Brown hair and eyes, 5'1", 135 lbs. Apodaca has a warrant for parole violation.
