## Suspicious Death

On May 31, 2022, Pueblo Police officers were dispatched to the 3000 block of N. Elizabeth on a welfare check. Several persons reported they had not seen their neighbor in several days, and wanted her welfare checked on.

Upon officers' arrival, they found an adult female deceased. There were suspicious circumstances surrounding the death, and Crimes Against Person's Detectives responded to the scene. Detectives are wanting to speak with 33-year-old, Tyler Jordan Mitchell as a person of interest regarding this case.

Tyler is currently wanted on two unrelated misdemeanor arrest warrants. Tyler is described as a white male, approximately 5'09", 155 lbs. with blonde hair. Tyler is known to keep his right arm in a sling due to a deformity.
