The Southern Colorado Safe Streets Task Force is attempting to locate two wanted street criminals.

Scott Mendoza (40) is described as a Hispanic male, 6'00", 190 pounds, with brown hair and brown eyes. Mendoza has five warrants for Failure to Appear, one of which is no bond. These warrants include the following charges: Weapon Offense-Possession of a Weapon by a Previous Offender, Traffic Offense-Vehicular Eluding, Trespassing, Theft and Making a False Report. His total bond amount is \$13,000.

Arden Haught (24) is described as a White male, 5'08", 150 pounds, with brown hair and blue eyes. Haught has three warrants for Failure to Appear which include the following charges: Aggravated Motor Vehicle Theft, Dangerous Drugs, Possession of a Controlled Substance, Possession of a Weapon by a Previous Offender, Property Crimes-Chop/Shop Alter/Remove VIN, and Registration-Fictitious Plates. His total bond amount is \$30,000.
