Officer-Involved Shootings

Pueblo police have had several recent officer-involved shootings. We are identifying the officers involved in these open, active investigations due to requests to identify the officers involved in these incidents.

On Sunday, June 26, 2022 an armed suicidal male raised his weapon when Pueblo police approached. The involved officer, Cpl. Richard Giconi was placed on administrative leave per standard protocol.

On Tuesday, June 28, 2022 suspects in a stolen vehicle shot at officers several times during a pursuit while driving down I-25 during the evening rush hour. The officer, Sergeant Richard Reyes was placed on administrative leave per standard protocol.

On Wednesday, June 29, 2022 officers were attempting to locate a suspect involved in shooting a female near the Fountain Creek. The suspect fired at officers when they approached. The officers on administrative leave for this incident are Officers Shawn Davis and Officer Jonathan Vicars per standard protocol.

The 10th Judicial District CIT (Critical Incident Team) led by the Pueblo County Sheriff's Office, will handle these investigations. The involved officers were placed on administrative leave per standard protocol for all shooting investigations.

The information contained in this press release is based on preliminary information available at the time of its drafting. The Pueblo Police Department's understanding of this incident may change as additional evidence is collected, analyzed and reviewed. The Pueblo Police Department does not draw any conclusions about whether the officers acted consistent with our policies and the law until all the facts are known and the investigation is complete. The purpose of this press release is to provide timely information to the public.
