Carjacking Arrests



July 13, 2022 [FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE]



On July 13, 2022 at approximately 5:30 p.m., Pueblo Police received a report of a carjacking at gunpoint in the 700 block of Patty Drive. The victim told police he was carjacked at gunpoint by two females.

At approximately 5:58 p.m., Pueblo Police located the victim's vehicle near the intersection of Santa Fe Ave. and W. City Center Drive. When police attempted to stop the car, a pursuit started that continued to the southside of Pueblo. Police attempted several techniques to stop the car during the pursuit.

The car was finally stopped in the 1400 block of Spruce St. after a Precision Intervention Technique (PIT). Both suspects were captured on scene. 21-year-old, Destiny Garcia-Martinez and 40-year-old, Fashawn Garcia were arrested on charges of Aggravated Robbery and Vehicular Eluding.

Garcia had an active arrest warrant for Aggravated Motor Vehicle Theft. Her previous involvements with Pueblo Police include 1st Degree Trespass, Aggravated Robbery, Theft, Criminal Mischief, Aggravated Motor Vehicle Theft, and Vehicular Assault.

The information contained in this press release is based on preliminary information available at the time of its drafting. The Pueblo Police Department's understanding of this incident may change as additional evidence is collected, analyzed and reviewed. The Pueblo Police Department does not draw any conclusions about whether the officers acted consistent with our policies and the law until all the facts are known and the investigation is complete.
