On Sunday, July 24, 2022, at approximately 12:16 p.m., Pueblo Police Department- CIS Detectives were actively looking for a wanted fugitive, 34-year-old, Samuel Jaramillo in the 2600 block of Alma Avenue.

Jaramillo was taken into custody by Pueblo police on warrants for felony Vehicular Eluding, Driving Under Restraint- Canceled/Denied, and Reckless Driving. While searching Jaramillo officers found a stolen Jimenez Arms .32 Auto handgun and a defaced Hi-Point .45 caliber handgun.

Jaramillo is a convicted felon for a Victims Rights Amendment (VRA) crime. Jaramillo was booked into the Pueblo County Jail on new criminal charges of Possession of a Weapon by Previous Offender (POWPO) two counts, Possession of a Defaced Firearm, and Theft, along with his warrant charges.

Jaramillo was previously featured twice as an FBI Wanted Safe Streets Criminal on February 21, 2020, and April 24, 2020.
